FACILITY RELOCATION

-By unanimous vote the men decided to list the property with Dana Vickers. She will list the property to start at \$450,000.00. Tommy and Rick have to sign the paperwork to make it official.

-Mrs. Vickers will also begin to search for tracts of land and existing buildings in the canton area for our relocation.

-Dan made a presentation, in which he proposed a 3,700 sq. ft. building on 1.5 acres @ \$80.00 per sq. ft. could be built for approximately \$375,000.00, which would be in line with our potential sale price. In that way we would not have to borrow any money. The architectural design would allow for development in phases to fit our finances as well as allowing for growth. The average building time is 4-5 months, which means that, regardless of building a new building or moving into an existing building, we will have to spend an undetermined time at a temporary location. We should begin to think about where we could meet at that time; library, school, etc.
